At first I would like to say I really appreciate to have the possibility to stay in the studio of Atelierhaus Salzamt.

It was a great exprerience to work in a new space with the view to Donau river.

During my stay I worked on a series of drawings (pencil and paper on different formats of paper - A1,A2,A3)

The goal was to put all drawings (format A3) together and glue them on the canavas and create a larger scale. That last step I finish back at my studio in Budweis.

I was looking for compassion and communication between individual drawings.

The great inspiration for me was basically the view from the window.

I was observing how the light is changing the surface of the river. Those little waves are also appearing on most of the drawings.

It was good experience to have my daughter with me during the stay and see how mother as artist can use the time for working in the studio. The Atelierhaus Salzamt is offering very good conditions for living and working in the same time for individual artists and artist parents too.
